ABOUT THE AWARDS

Allan-Jack Memorial Award | \$2,000

The winner of this award becomes ineligible to receive this award again in the future.

Bonnie J. Thomas Memorial Award | \$600

Awarded to a string player.

Hannah Robertson Memorial Award | Two prizes of \$600 each

Awarded to musicians under the age of 16.

Harriet Scott Memorial Award | \$600

ELIGIBILITY

- Registered in school at the time of application and playing an orchestral instrument (including piano and voice).
- A resident of Kingston or a surrounding community (up to 85 km) for four years or more.
- In elementary or high school.
- In university studying music, in first or second year of an undergraduate program, and meet the residency requirements as listed above.
