ABOUT THE AWARDS

Allan-Jack Memorial Award | \$2,000

The winner becomes ineligible to receive this award again in the future.

Bonnie J. Thomas Memorial Award | \$600

Awarded to a string player.

Hannah Robertson Memorial Award | Two prizes of \$600 each

Awarded to musicians under the age of 16.

Harriet Scott Memorial Award | \$600

ELIGIBILITY

- A resident of Kingston or the surrounding community (up to 85 km) for four years or more.
- Registered in an elementary or high school, and plays an orchestral instrument.
- Enrolled in a first- or second-year undergraduate university music program, and meets the residency requirement.
