Here's a breakdown of what this means for you as a viewer.



1. Purchase a ticket for \$15 plus HST to access our concert online.



2. Receive a special link to the concert by email, 48 hours before the performance begins.



3. Tune into the pre-concert talk, hosted by Maestro Evan Mitchell, on Sunday, September 26 at 2:00 p.m.



4. Enjoy our livestreamed performance on Sunday, September 26 at 2:30 p.m. from the comfort of your own home.

Will the Kingston Symphony concerts be digital from now on?

Our goal is to return to live performances with an audience as soon as it is safe to do so and the capacity restrictions allow for more people. For the first concert of our season, the performance will only be available online. We will not be selling tickets to attend in person.

Can I buy a subscription? Why do I have to buy a single ticket?
